# LION

-

  - With some males exceeding 250 kg in weight, it is the second -largest living cat after the tiger.
  - They live in Sub-Saharan Africa and in Asia, Other types of lions live in North Africa and South West Asia.
  - Lions live for 10-14 years.
  - Lions eat meat.



# GIRAFFE

- The giraffe is the tallest terrestrial animal and the largest ruminant. The weight of the giraffe is 1.600 kg
- The giraffe extends from Chad in the north of South Africa to Niger in the west to Somalia.
- The giraffe lives 10 years approximately.
  - Giraffes usually inhabit in savannahs, grasslands, and open woodlands. Their primary food is acacia leaves.

# CHEETAH

·The cheetah is the fastest animal in the world.

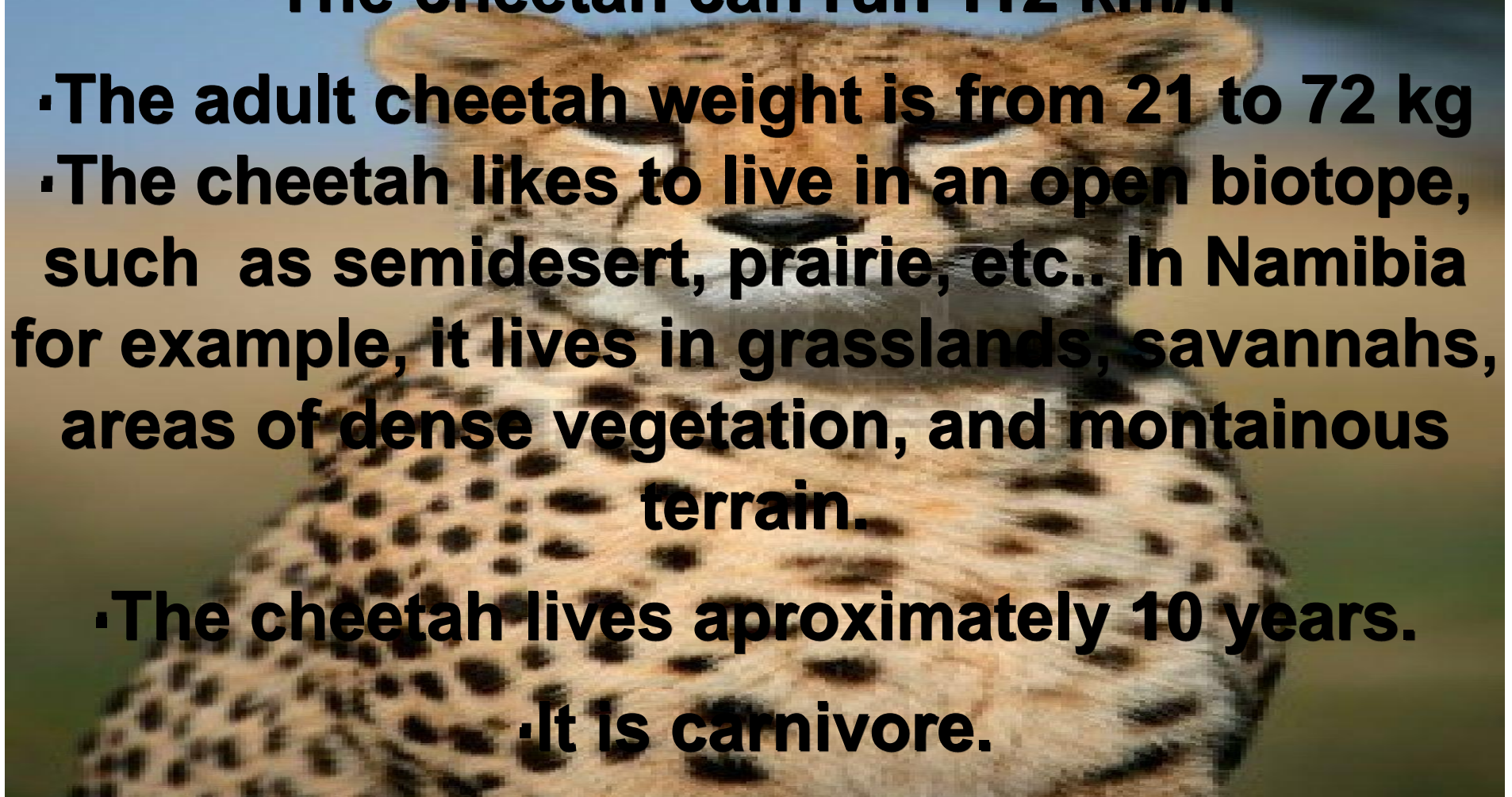
The cheetah can run 112 km/h

·The adult cheetah weight is from 21 to 72 kg


·The cheetah likes to live in an open biotope, such as semidesert, prairie, etc.. In Namibia for example, it lives in grasslands, savannahs, areas of dense vegetation, and mountainous terrain.

·The cheetah lives approximately 10 years.

·It is carnivore.



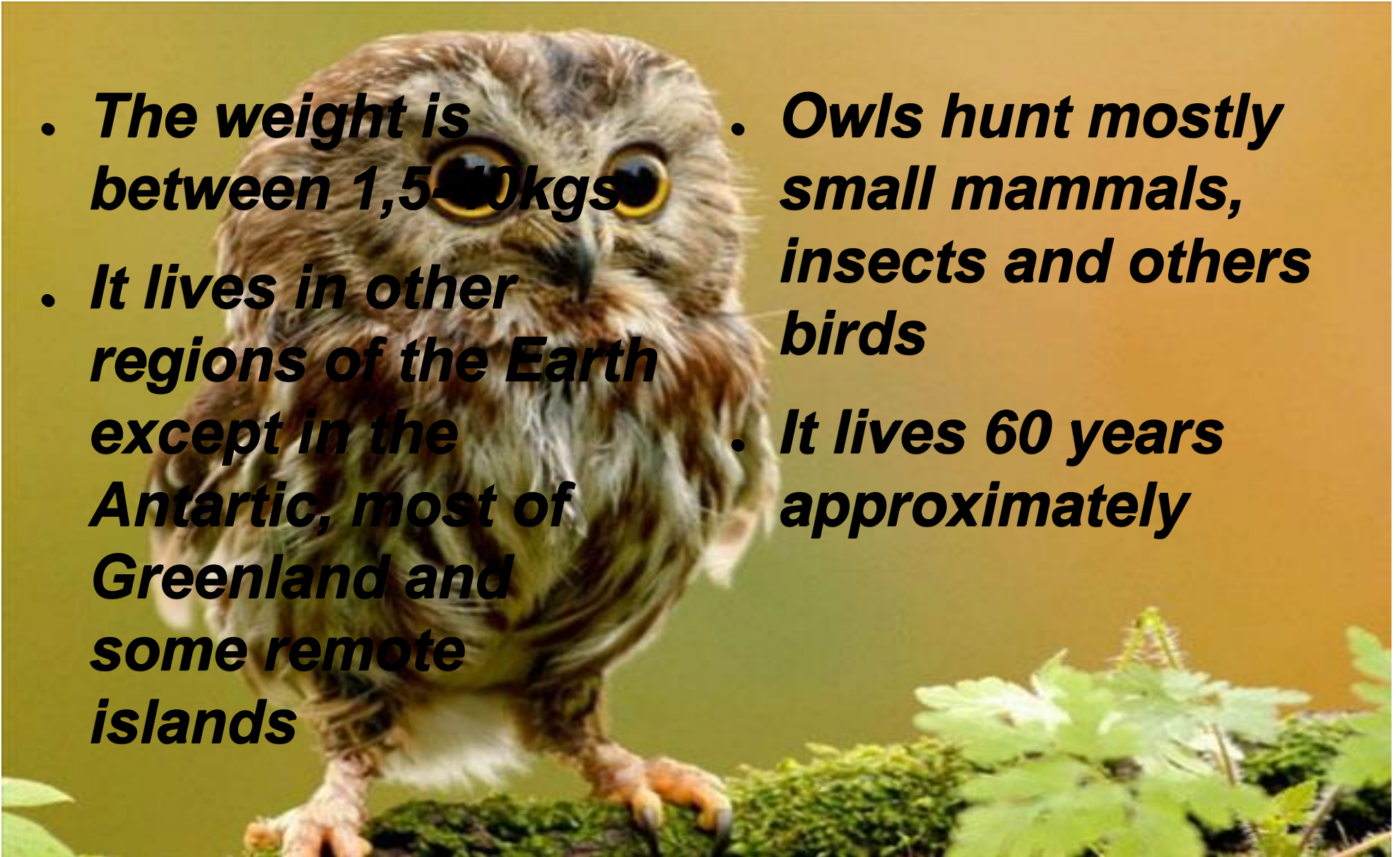




***FOREST ANIMALS***

# OWL

- The weight is between 1,5-10kgs***
- It lives in other regions of the Earth except in the Antarctic, most of Greenland and some remote islands***
- Owls hunt mostly small mammals, insects and others birds***
- It lives 60 years approximately***




# WOLF

- *It's a mammal*
  - *The weight is between 12-70kgs*
  - *The wolf lives worldwide*
  - *It lives 15-16 years*
  - *approximately*
  - *It's the ancestor of the domestic dog*
  - *It's a carnivorous animal: It eats elk, mice, birds and even fish*
  - *It eats earthworms, berries and*
  - *grasshoppers*

# FOX

- ***It's a mammal***
  - ***Its weight is 2'5-10'5 kg***
  - ***It lives in the forests, prairies and near the farms***
  - ***It's omnivorous: the fox hunts birds and small mammals (squirrels, rabbits and mice) and it eats fruit, berries and grass***
  - ***There are 27 different species***

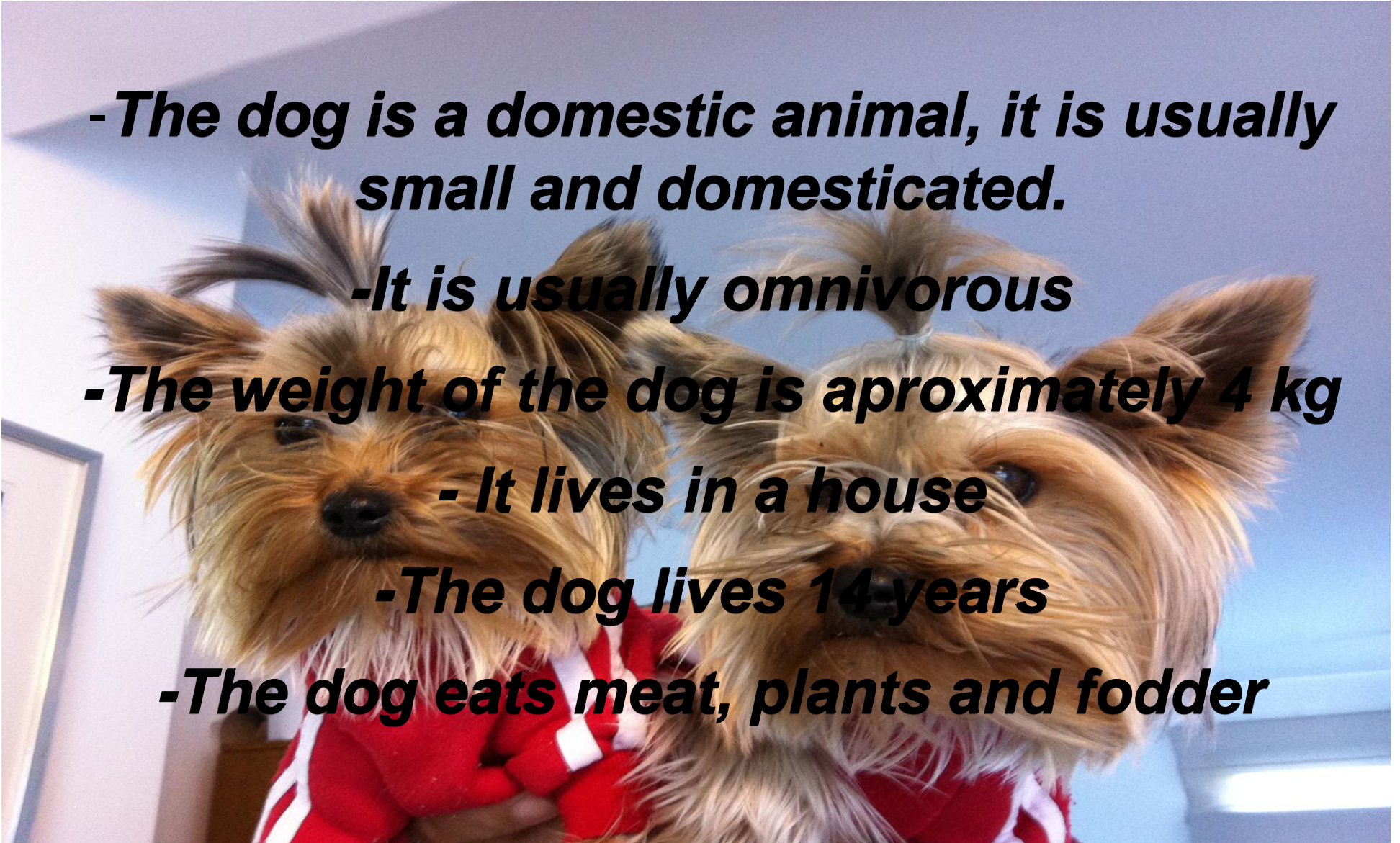
# ***DOMESTIC ANIMALS***

# Hamster

- Hamsters are rodents belonging to the subfamily Cricetinae.***
- The weight of the hamster is 1 kg approximately***

- .-The hamster eat vegetables. It is hervivorous.***

# Cat
