Hawaii

- It is in Polynesia, in the central Pacific Ocean.
- Hawaii's diverse natural scenery, warm tropical climate, abundance of public beaches, oceanic surroundings, and active volcanoes, make it a popular destination for tourists, surfers, biologists and volcanologists alike.
- Hawaii's climate is typical for the tropics, although temperatures and humidity tend to be a bit less extreme due to constant trade winds from the east. The temperature is around 28°C during every year.



Nantucket

- It is 30 miles south of Cape Cod, Massachusetts, in the United States.
- Nantucket is a prominent tourist destination. The population of the island increases to about 50.000 during the summer months, due to tourists and seasonal residents.
- Nantucket was formed by the uttermost reach of the Laurentide Ice Sheet during the recent Wisconsin Glaciation, shaped by the subsequent rise in sea level.
- Nantucket features a climate that borders between a humid continental climate and an oceanic climate.



The Bahamas

- It is in the Atlantic Ocean, being located just north of Cuba, northwest of the Turks and Caicos Islands and east of the Florida peninsula.
- Nassau is the most interesting city to visit in the Bahamas; there are many architectural buildings to see, from Victorian houses to modern luxury apartments. For shopping, you can do in Nassau on Bay Street and in the old town, where they sell traditional crafts. Grand Bahama beaches are white sand and crystal clear water, so it is visited by divers.
- The climate of the archipelago is tropical.
