She was an American jazz singer often referred to as the First Lady of Song, Queen of Jazz and Lady Ella.

She was noted for her purity of tone singing.

While Fitzgerald appeared in movies and as a guest on popular television shows .

In 1996, she died at the age of 79 years .

One of her most popular songs is "Cabin in the Sky".

**Louis Armstrong** was an American jazz trumpeter, composer and singer who became one of the most influential figures in jazz music. Armstrong was a foundational influence in jazz. With his instantly recognizable gravelly voice, Armstrong was also a great singer, demonstrating great expertise as an improviser. His most popular song is “What a Wonderful World”.

# Candy Dulfer

**Candy Dulfer** is a Dutch smooth jazz and funk alto saxophonist who began playing at the age of six.

She founded her band, Funky Stuff, when she was fourteen years old.

Her debut album *Saxuality* (1990) received a Grammy Award nomination.

Dulfer has released nine studio albums, two live albums, and one compilation album.

In 2013, she became a judge in the fifth season of the Dutch version of *The X Factor*.

• AC/DC are an Australian hard rock band, formed in November 1973 by brothers Malcolm and Angus Young, who continued as members until Malcolm's illness and departure in 2014.

• The band's logo was designed in 1977 by Gerard Huerta. It first appeared on the international version of "Let There Be Rock".

• In 2003, the band was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

•Malcolm Mitchell Young, born on the 6<sup>th</sup> January of 1953, was a retired Australian musician of Scottish origin.

Best known as a founder, rhythm guitarist, backing vocalist and songwriter of the Australian hard rock band AC/DC.

•On 16<sup>th</sup> April of 2014, Young got sick.

•Soon after, he died because of several complications related to his illness.
