



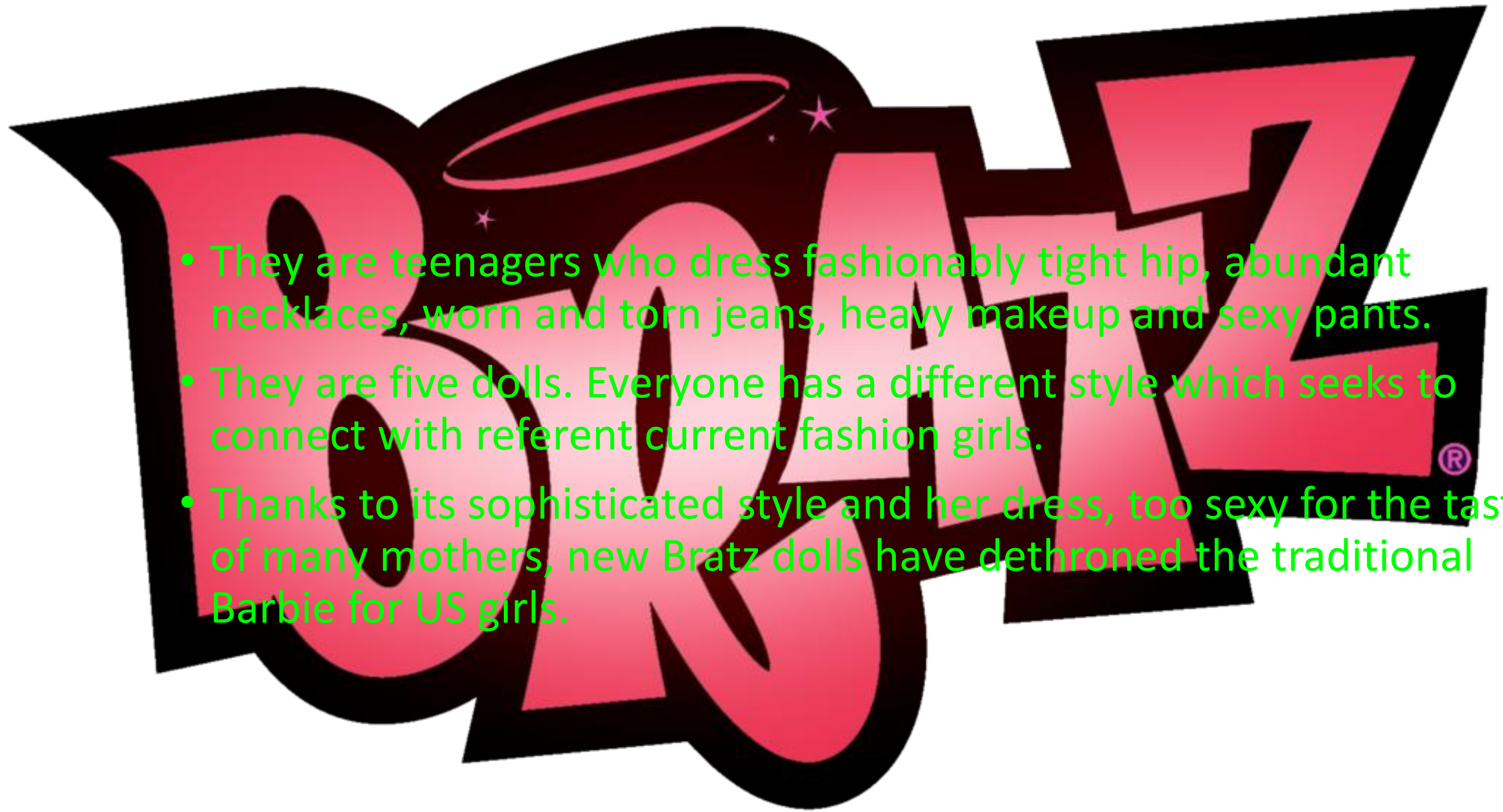

The history of Ann dolls began in 1936.

- Nancy Ann dressed dolls was incorporated on February 23 , 1937 in San Francisco, California.
- By 1942 , the company claimed a million dollar reached 12, 000 per day .
- In late 1945 , the company's name was changed to Nancy

History of Nancy

- The storybook dolls began being produced in late 1936.
- In California, in 1939, artists painted the facial features, therefore, giving each doll its own special look.



History of Nancy

- By the late 1.940s, the company was producing the largest doll volume in the nation . However, in the 1.950s and 1.960s, the company's production decreased.

History

- Ruth and Elliot Handler founded Mattel Creations in 1945, and 14 years later, Ruth Handler gave the world the Barbie doll.
- The inspiration for Barbie came as Ruth watched her daughter Barbara playing with paper dolls. Barbara and her friends used them to play adult or teenage make-believe, imagining roles as college students, cheerleaders and adults with careers.

Professions

- She first broke the “plastic ceiling” in the 1960s when, as an astronaut, she went to the moon... four years before Neil Armstrong.
- In the 80s, she took to the boardroom as “Day to Night” CEO Barbie, just as women began to break into the C-suite. And in the 90s, she ran for President, before any female candidate ever made it onto the presidential ballot.

Her Boyfriend

- Barbie has a lots of best friends. Barbie doll's boyfriend, Ken, debuted two years after Barbie in 1961.
- Starting out with nine outfits, a skinny frame and fuzzy crew cut ,he's always stood by Barbie.
- Ken and Barbie broke up on Valentine's Day in 2004 after being together more than 43 years. They announced their reunion after seven years of being apart on Valentine's Day 2011.
