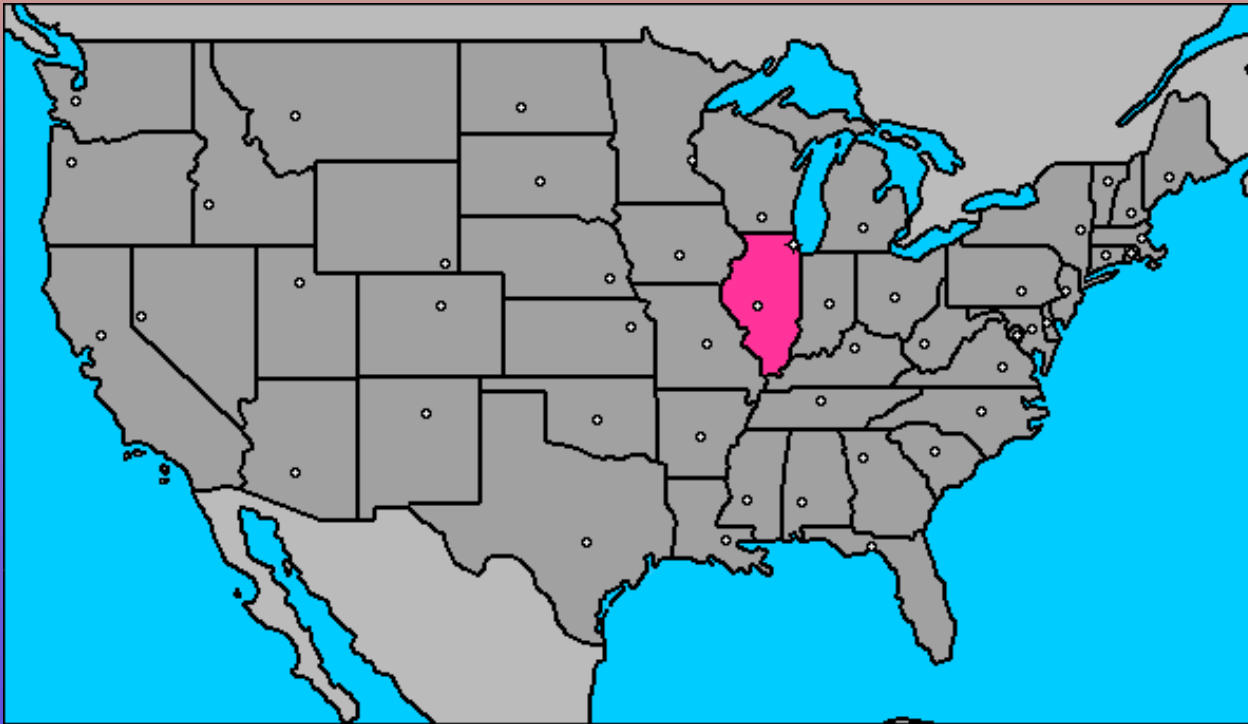

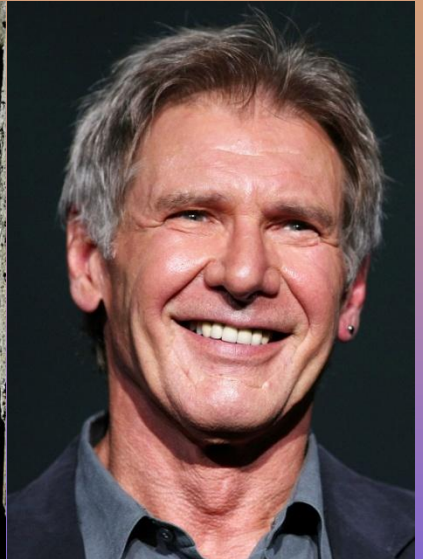

- This corporation is now known as **The Walt Disney Company**.



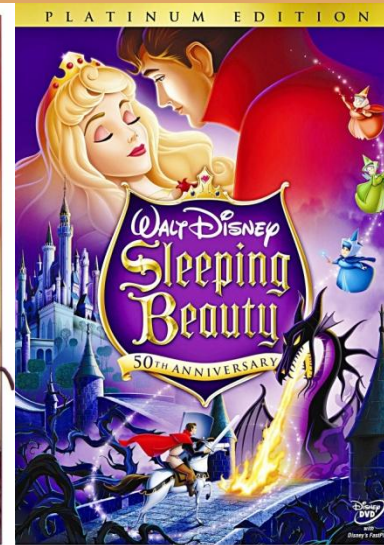

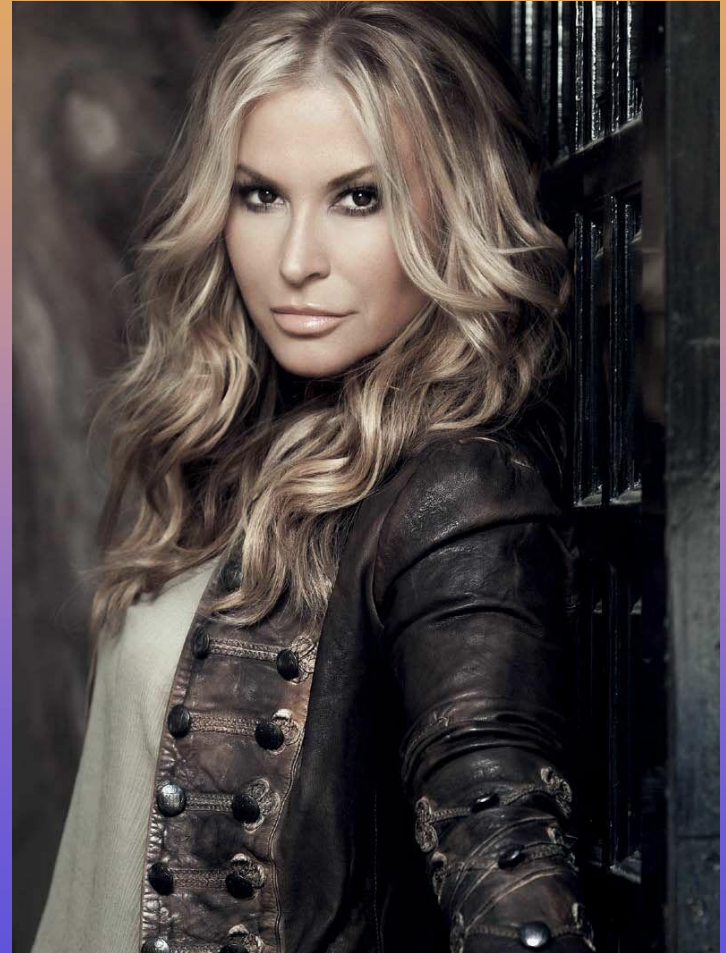
BONNIE HUNT

- She has done voice work in the Pixar films Monsters Inc., Monsters University, Toy Story 3...



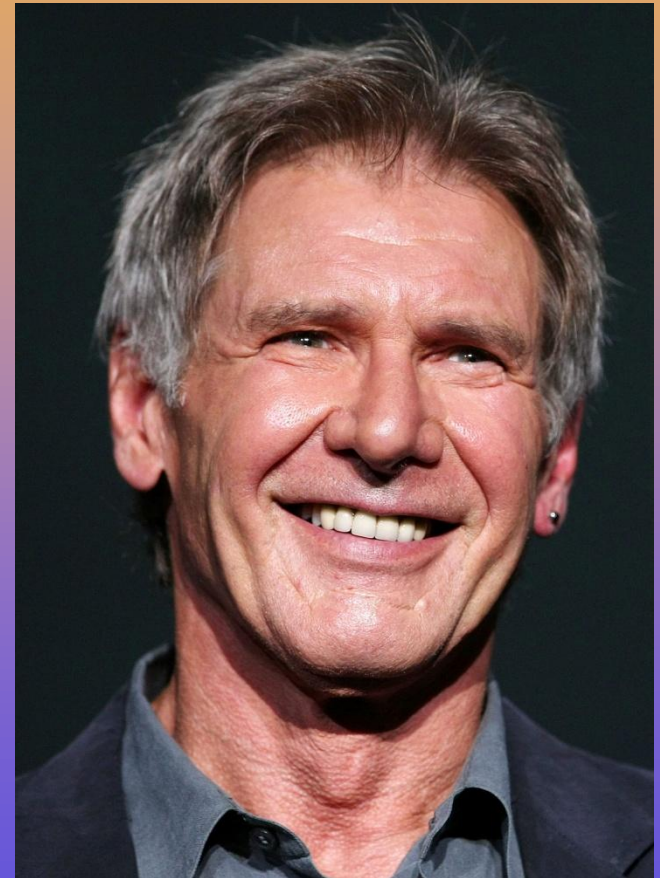
ANASTACIA

- The Millennium park is a recreational and artistic urban development in the city of Chicago. The park is between Michigan, Columbus Drive and Randolph and Monroe streets.
- Millennium park has won several awards. The most important thing of this park is the concert hall Jay Pritzker. There is also the sculpture Cloud Gate, the source Crown Fountain, and the garden Lurie.



- The [Field Museum of Natural History](#) was founded in 1893. It's in the city of Chicago in Illinois state. It's one of the biggest and most important museums of the world's natural history. It has more than 20.000.000 objects of nature and culture, and it has a library with about 250.000 books of biology, systematic and anthropology.
- The architect who built it was [Daniel Burnham](#) and it's of neoclassical style.
