




LOCATION




 San Francisco s palace: It s a neoclassic building designed by the architect Gastón Lelarge in 1917

Las Vegas is located geographically in the high Mojave Desert, within the State of Nevada. In the metropolitan area, the population is almost 2 millions inhabitants.




BUILDINGS OF LAS VEGAS
