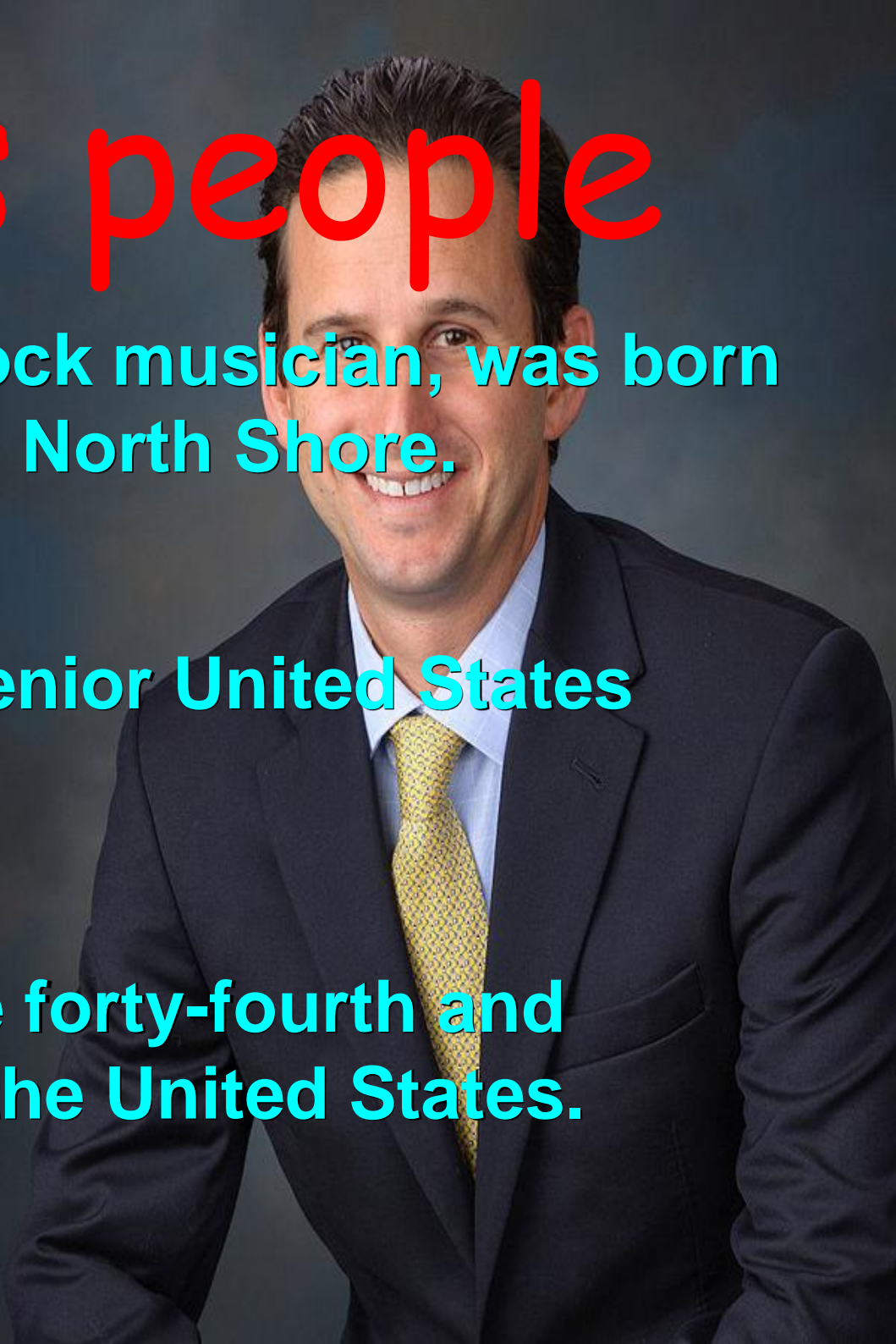
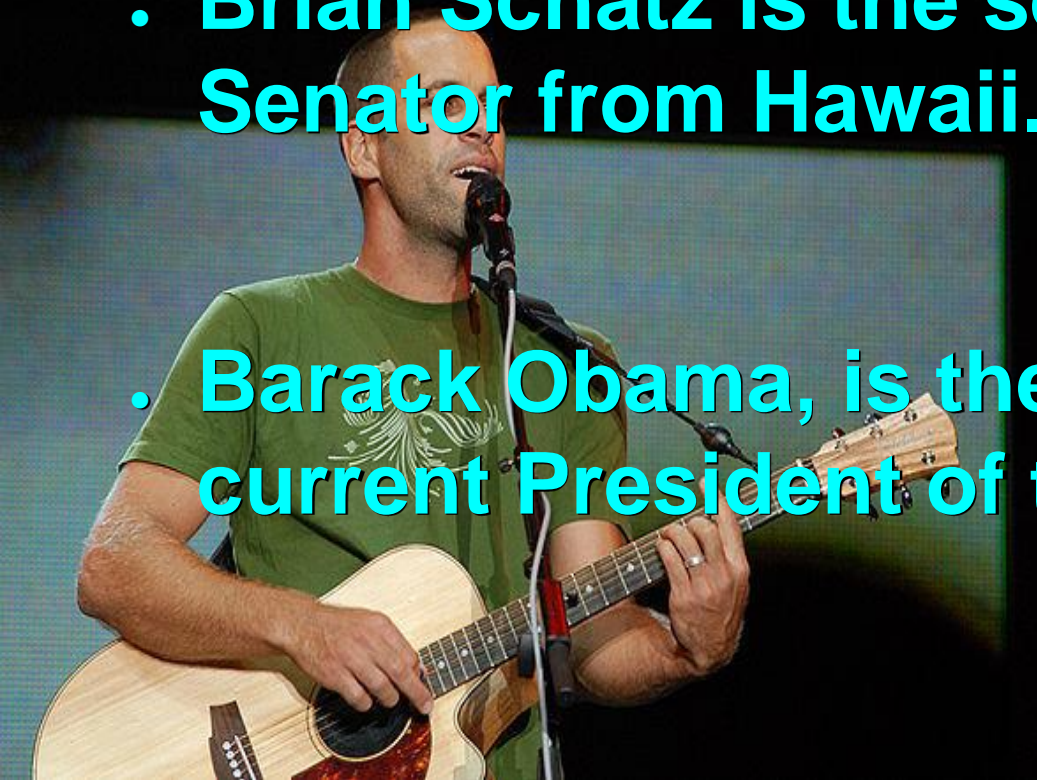


# Famous people

• Barack Obama, is the forty-fourth and current President of the United States.

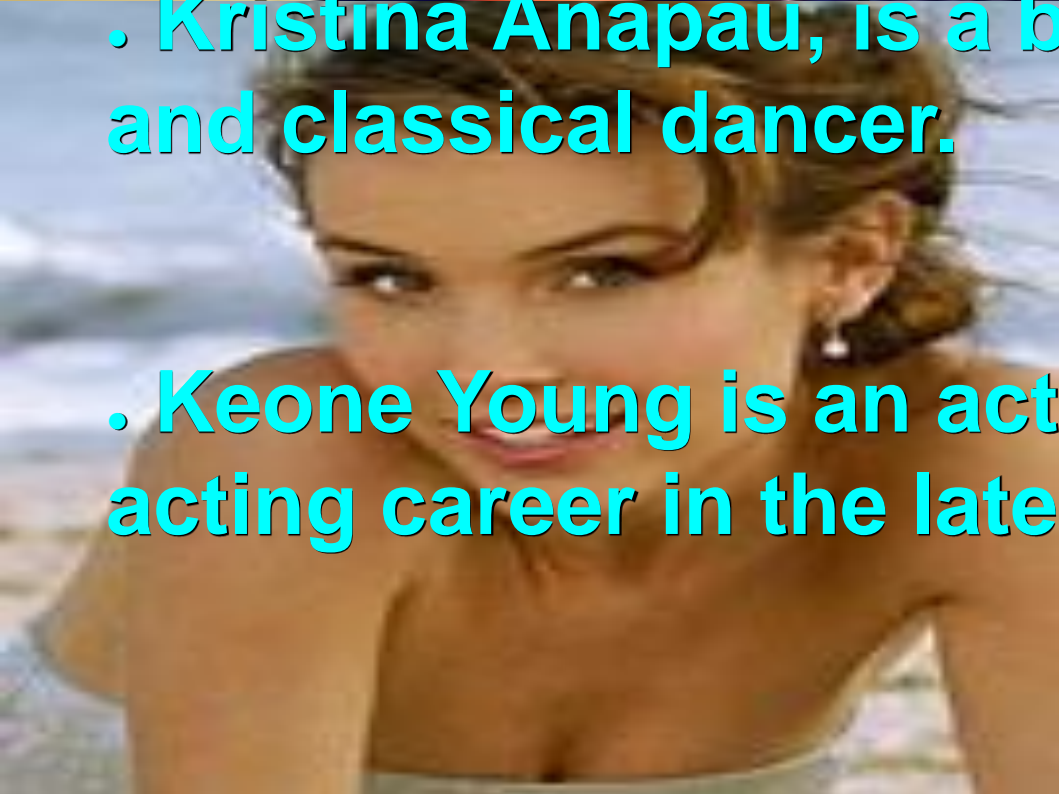


**. Bruno Mars is a singer, songwriter and music producer, born in Honolulu.**

. It is Makiki Christian Church in Honolulu.

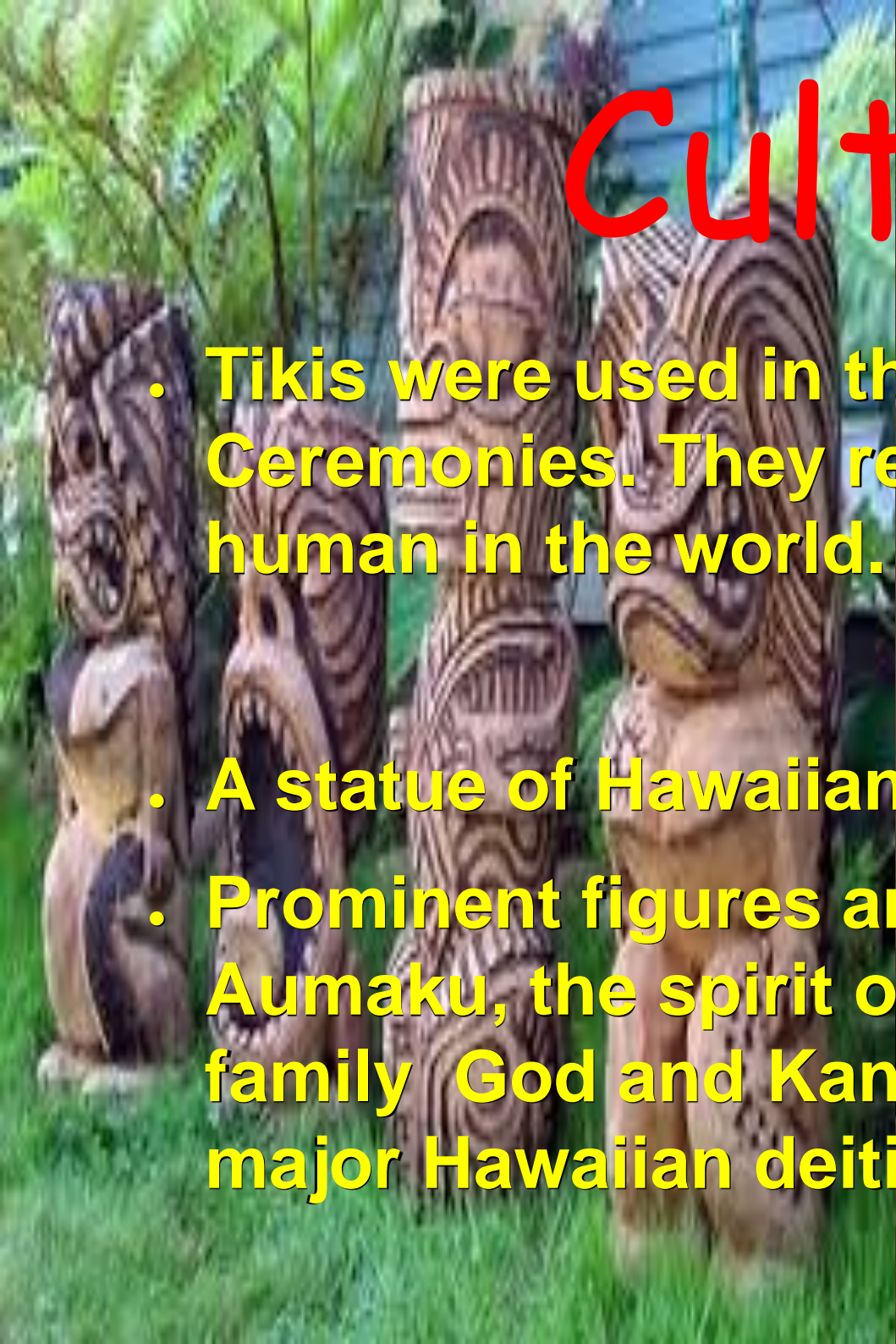


. The famous Lanikai Beach on Oahu.

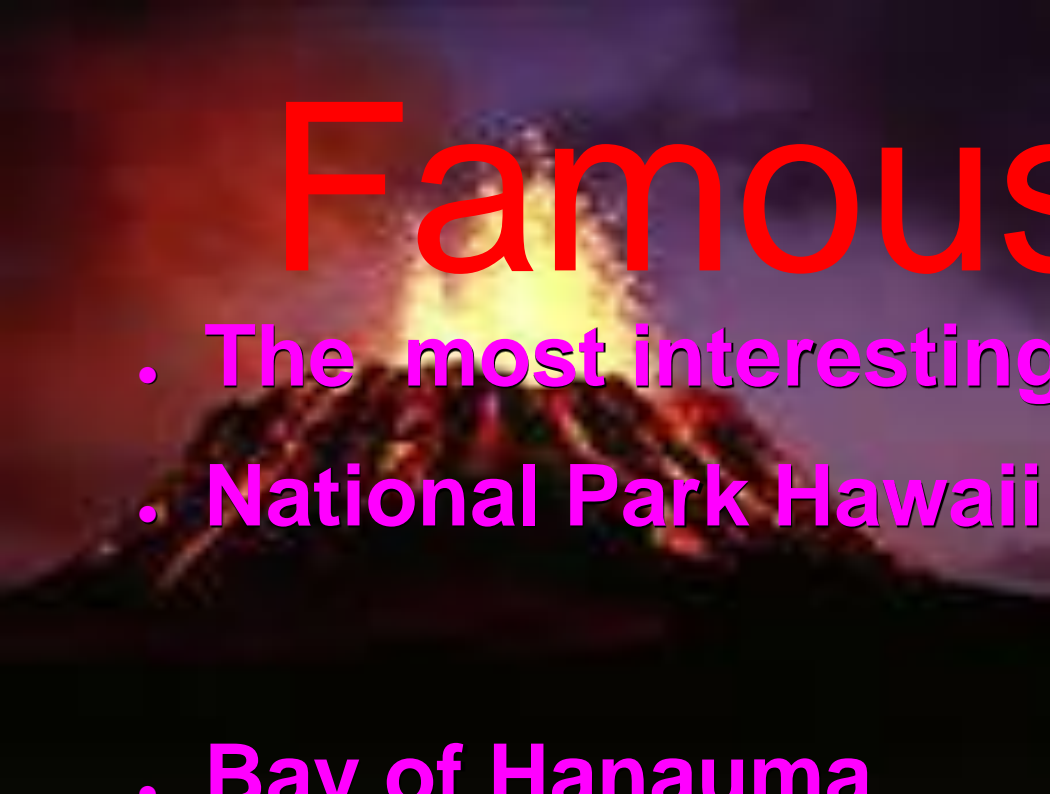
