HOUSE LALAURIE

• At the heart of the French Quarter, it is a mansion in the 1800s belonged to Luis Lalaurie doctor and his wife Delphine. The woman is responsible for the murder of a 12 year old. - He can be found in sections of woods, in front of the windows, and also he has been seen with large groups of children.
