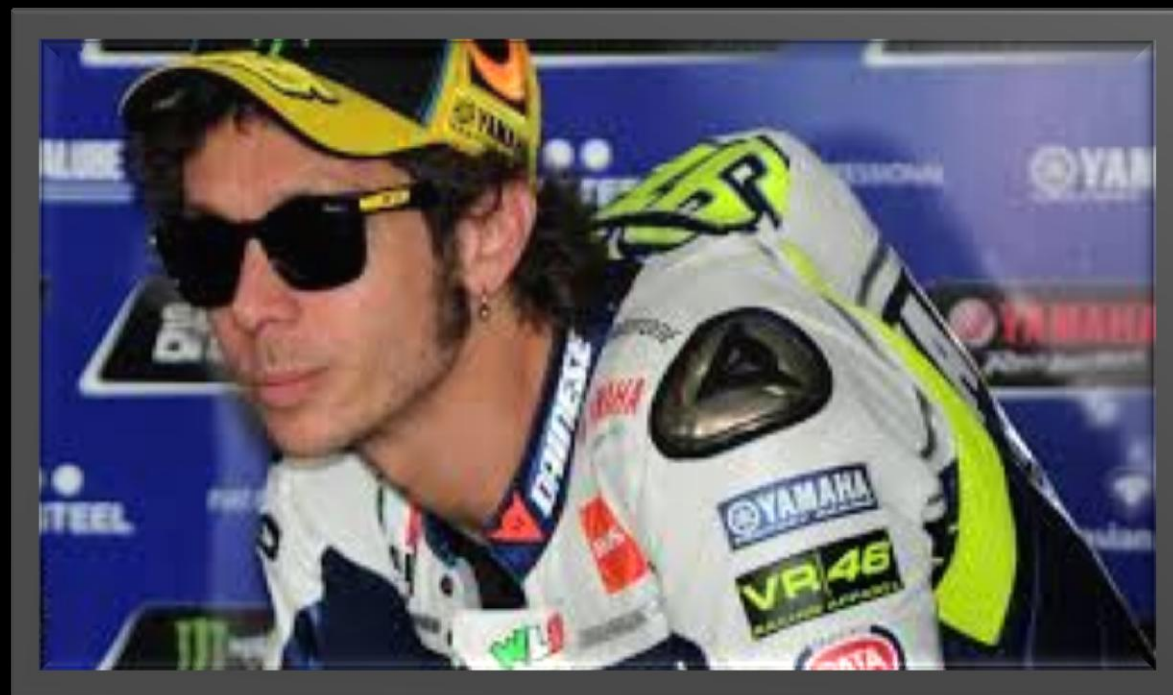

BIOGRAPHY

- Valentino Rossi was born on 16th of february in 1979 in Urbino, Italy. His nickname is "The Doctor".
- His parents are Graziano Rossi and Stefania Palma. When he was little he lived in Tavullia.
- He is a very important Italian motorcyclist in the world of Moto GP. He started on the theme of the motorcycle in 1990.



SPONSORS

- He has a lot of sponsors. For example Eneos, Movistar, Yamaha, Fiat ...
- Eneos is an enterprise of petrol station and his headquarter is in Japon. It was made in 1888.

GRAND PRIX

- Nowadays, he is the pilot with more 190 podiums, 59 poles and 4.971 points in the history of the Motor racing's World one.
- In 2004, Rossi competed for Yamaha and in 2005 Rossi won again the world one of motorcycling in the race disputed in the Sepang's track.





Jorge Lorenzo



BIOGRAPHY

- He is a Spanish professional motorcycle road racer. He is the 2006 and 2007 250cc World Champion, and the 2010 and 2012 Moto GP World Champion. His complete name is Jorge Lorenzo Guerrero.
- He currently competes in the Moto GP class, competing for the factory Yamaha team.



125CC AND 250CC

- Lorenzo made his championship debut on his fifteenth birthday, on the second qualifying day for the 2002 125cc Spanish Grand Prix, after having to miss Friday practice as he was not old enough to race.
- Jorge's victory at Misano in 2007 was his 16th in the 250cc class, making him the most successful Spanish rider of all time in the 250cc GP class with one more victory than Dani Pedrosa and Sito Pons.



- After being linked with a Yamaha Moto GP ride for 2008, on 25 July 2007 he was confirmed as Valentino Rossi's partner on a two-year deal for the 2008 Moto GP season.

- Marc Marquez Alenta was born on 17th of february of 1993 in Cervera, Lerida, Spain.
- He has got a brother and his name is Alex Marquez. His parents are Julia Marquez and Roser Alenta.
- He is a Spanish motorcyclist. He is a first young motorcyclist that won MotoGP. He started in 1998.

- His team is Repsol Honda.



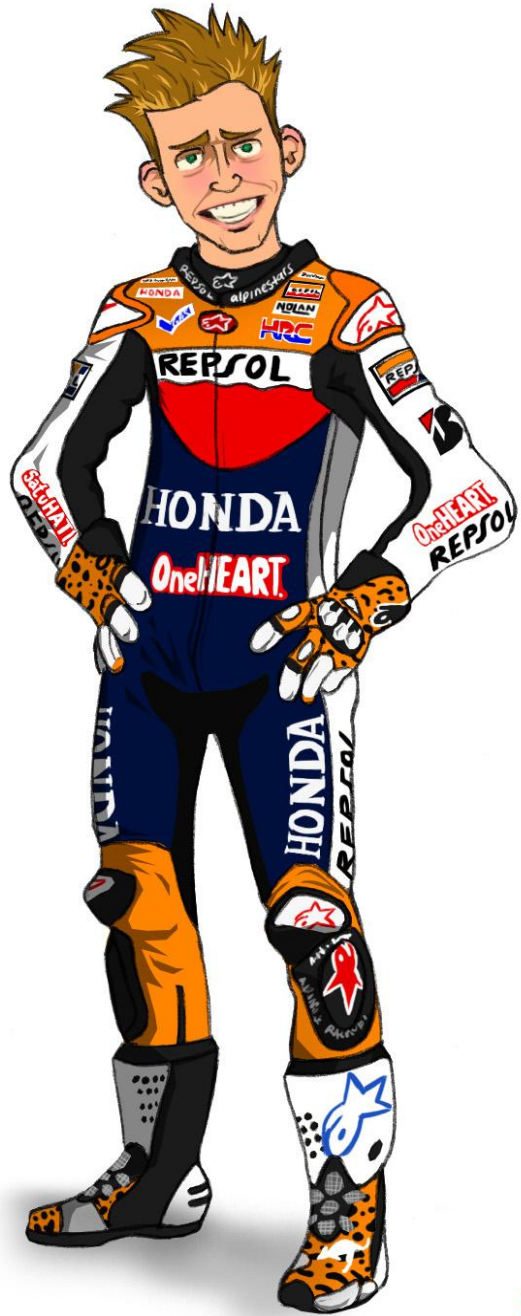

- He got thirteen victories out of eighteen during the season.

- He is one of four riders to have won world championship titles in three different categories, after Mike Hailwood, Phil Read and Valentino Rossi.
